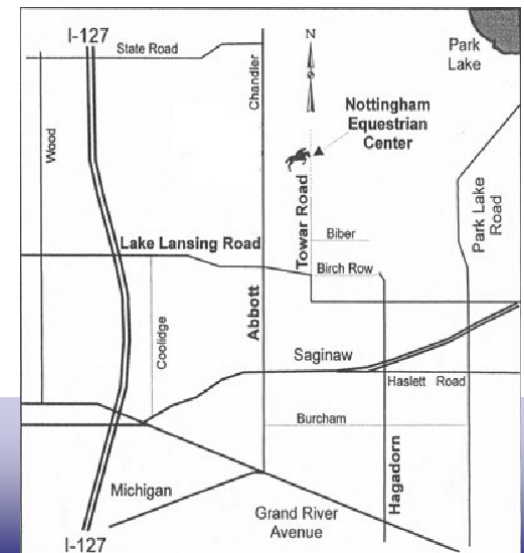

CAMP PROGRAM

Each day of camp will include grooming and tacking of one of our well-trained ponies or horses for a one hour mounted

lesson. The lessons will work on improving riders' balance and position as well as coordination

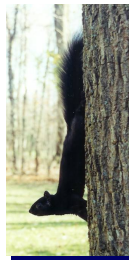
with their horses in different riding patterns and exercises. Immediately after their lesson, campers will enjoy a short, relaxing trail ride around the farm.



The remaining camp hours will be filled with both educational and recreational activities.

Horse educational topics include presentations from our barn farrier and visiting veterinarians on horse health issues. Recreational activities include daily arts and crafts projects, a variety of games using newly learned horse skills and gymnastics exercises on a bareback voltege horse.

This year we are excited to be offering a session called "**Nottingham Nature Nook**" in each week of camp. During this afternoon session, all the campers will learn about the local wildlife and plants that surround



Nottingham. Time will be spent with a local wildlife biologist and wildlife rehabilitator who will take the children on a guided nature walk. The session will finish with a project that the campers can bring home to benefit their local wildlife.

WHEN

Camp meets Monday - Friday, 9am to 3pm. Check-in is between 8:45 and 9 am Monday morning. Campers will perform a riding demonstration on Friday afternoon with a party for family and friends following.

FEES

Sessions are limited to 12 students, ages 6 to 12 years . The fee for the week is \$275. A second week may be attended for \$250. A \$150 deposit is required for each child for each session and should be included with the camp application. Before and after care can are available for \$9/hr, prepaid at Monday morning check-in.
